From the picking of the first apple in September and the squashing of the last pear in December, to the careful Springtime blending, Summer events, and Winter orchard pruning.

With the help of Heritage Lottery funding, the WPCS are creating four museum orchards across Wales to preserve the Welsh varieties of Perry pear and Cider apple, in addition to our existing one at Raglan Cider Mill.
